(Based on the rules for the season 2018-19 and considering certain amendment / modification to the rules as approved by the Managing Committee in its meeting on 15.9.2019)

Unless it is clear that there is a contrary intention, wherever in any provision / norms stated below there are words referring to the masculine gender, the words should be construed to incorporate the feminine gender and vice versa as the case may be. Also, words in the singular include the plural as and when required to clarify the relevance and intent.

BACKGROUND :

Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association organises various age group and gender based cricket tournaments termed as 'Inter Divisional Tournaments' during a cricket season. The Inter Divisional Tournaments are played as under

In addition to the above, MPCA has introduced following new multi-day tournaments w.e.f. season 2018-19. These tournaments feature 3 sides viz. winner of the Inter Divisional Tournament (multi-day) + 2 teams comprising of players from remaining teams (Rest of MP 'A') and (Rest of MP 'B')

The participation of players, aspiring and professional, in such tournaments requires certain set of rules / norms governing the eligibility of players so that parity is maintained and the competition amongst the teams is fair.

Players desirous to participate in the above tournaments from any Division should first ascertain the eligibility for any of the participating teams. Registration of player is essential to record the willingness to participate in



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such tournament. Such registration shall be governed by appropriate norms so that the guidelines of BCCI can be followed effectively when the selection procedure of the MP team takes place. In absence of adherence to such norms, MPCA may land in a situation where the performing players cannot be considered in the selection procedure and the purpose of inter divisional tournament is diluted.

This document covers the following set of rules / norms

- i. Players eligibility rules & procedures
- ii. Players registration rules & procedures

PLAYERS ELIGIBILITY RULES & PROCEDURES

1. These rules shall be called as **“Players Eligibility Rules”** and shall be effective from **season 2019/20** and shall supersede any other rules in force till then.
2. These rules are meant for ascertaining the eligibility of a cricketer to play in the **MPCA Inter Divisional Tournament / any other tournament** as specified by the Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association.
3. MPCA domestic season shall commence from **1st September** and continue till the last match of the season irrespective of the category of tournament.
4. The preliminary responsibility for assessment and confirmation of eligibility of player to represent any Division shall be with the concerned player subject to the Division adopting elaborative steps to create awareness amongst the players.

MPCA shall annually provide players registration forms to each Division by stipulated date. Such forms shall contain the eligibility rules as well. The forms shall be in English and Hindi.

The Divisions are required to distribute such forms with documented evidence (like by issue of a media statement, or a letter to the districts / clubs under the Division etc.)

In case if any Division is not able to demonstrate its efforts towards creating such awareness, the Hon. Secretary of such Division shall be responsible.

5. ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

A player can represent only one Division in one cricket season. This is irrespective of multiple tournaments for a particular category / age group.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS TO REPRESENT DIVISION



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i. A player desirous to participate in any Inter Divisional Tournament conducted by MPCA shall be eligible to represent a particular Division on the basis of the following pre-requisites :

a. **Birth qualification :**

Any Divisional Association within whose jurisdiction the player is born.

OR

b. **Bonafide residence qualification :**

Any Divisional Association within whose jurisdiction the player has been a bonafide resident for a period of **ONE YEAR** before the commencement of the season. (*i.e. the player should be a bonafide resident of a particular division from 1st September of the previous year.*)

OR

c. **Bonafide employment / education qualification :**

Any Divisional Association within whose jurisdiction the player (personal / parents in case of players upto 21 years) has been into a **bonafide employment** for a period of **THREE MONTHS** before the commencement of the particular season.

NEW

'Part-time' employee, 'trainee' employee shall not be treated as condition for bonafide employment. Bonafide employment to include government, semi-government, corporate, autonomous bodies, MSE etc. and not working at places like small shops, personal enterprise etc. The condition should reveal that the parents have a strong reason to shift their native place for occupation.

Any Divisional Association within whose jurisdiction the player (personal) has been into a bonafide educational course for a period of **THREE MONTHS** before the commencement of the particular season.

Wherever any player is registering in a school within our jurisdiction (**while his birth and bonafide residence is outside state of MP**) such players should have completed atleast one full academic year with such school before being eligible for participation (one full year means and includes appearing for yearly exam from such school)

and

Such player shall be treated as **GUEST PLAYER (EDUCATION)** with a restriction of maximum one player per team.

OR

d. **Change in residence due to studies /employment :**



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Any cricketer in the course of change in employment (personal / parents in case of players upto 21 years) or studies (personal) is transferred from limits of one division to the limits of the other division during the period of **THREE MONTHS** before the commencement of the particular season subject

In case of c and d above, if any player is not able to conform the condition of 3 months, as the case may be, he shall be eligible to represent his erstwhile Division (if he has represented in any inter divisional tournament earlier) or if representing for the first time then the Division of his birth / bonafide residence for 1 year.

OR

e. Guest Player :

Any Divisional Cricket Association will be allowed to include **FOUR GUEST PLAYERS** in their squad and only **FOUR GUEST PLAYERS** will be permitted in the playing XI of a team at a given point of time on following pattern:

- (i) **Maximum 2 players can be from any other Division under MPCA;**
- (ii) **Maximum 1 player can be from outside Madhya Pradesh;**
- (iii) **Maximum 1 player covered under (c) above**

In case any Division does not desire to field any player from out of Madhya Pradesh (i.e. (ii) above), such Division may field the third guest player from any other Division (i.e. (i) above).

The category (iii) above shall remain exclusive for players under education requirement if need be.

In case of the Guest Player whose birth / bonafide residence is outside the jurisdiction of Madhya Pradesh the following provision shall be applicable –

Eligibility for Senior Tournament : The players should demonstrate his registration / participation in domestic tournament of any Division for **atleast 2 years before the season for which applying for registration.**

Eligibility for Junior Tournament : The players should demonstrate his registration / participation in domestic tournament of any Division for **atleast 1 year before the season for which applying for registration.**



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This is to clarify that any player registered with MPCA so far, i.e. 2018-19 or any season prior to this, who has been historically representing a Division of his choice till the season 2018-19, can continue to do so as a local player of such division provided -

For senior tournaments : He has represented atleast 5 seasons for such Division (atleast one match in playing XI per season) during 8 preceding seasons or more.

For junior tournaments : He has represented atleast 3 seasons for such Division (atleast one match in playing XI per season) during 5 preceding seasons or more.

6. Aiming to curb the practice of shifting from one division to other for mere superficial reasons, all players, except those under the 'Guest Player' desirous to represent any Division must have played atleast TWO MULTI DAY MATCHES OR FOUR LTD. OVERS / T-20 MATCHES ORGANISED BY THAT DIVISION.

7. DISQUALIFICATION

- I. If any player who is not qualified under the above referred 'Players Eligibility Rules' to play for any Divisional Team, in case plays any match for such Division, the player shall be disqualified from playing in the rest of the matches / tournament and any other tournament for any team during that season of MPCA.
- II. If a player is found to be guilty of getting registered on the basis of fake or forged documents then he will be debarred from participating in any MPCA tournament for a period of two cricket seasons of MPCA provided –

NEW

- a. **Where a player has not played / allowed to play any match during the season, the said season shall be counted as a part of the two years prohibition period.**
- b. **Where a player has played one / more match during the season, the prohibition shall be for the current season + 2 seasons thereafter.**

In the interests of the players, the above scheme shall come into force with retrospective effect i.e. w.e.f. season 2017-18 (first season of centralised implementation of rules). Prohibition period of any player as at the start of season 2019-20 shall be recomputed by MPCA.

- III. In addition to above, the Division which fields such player (who is not qualified under the above referred rules in its team) such team shall be disqualified from participating in the rest of the tournament and also shall forfeit all their points in the tournament. The points earned by the other teams against such Division shall also be cancelled for the tournament. In addition, the



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Division will have to pay a penalty of Rs. 50,000/- to MPCA. It is clarified that if any player has submitted forged / counterfeit documents, the Division shall not be responsible unless it is established with evidence that the Division was aware of such forged / counterfeit document.

NEW

If it is established that any Office Bearer, or Coach, or any responsible person associated with the Division is involved, or has played a role for procuring / preparing counterfeit document of birth etc. for any player, such person shall be treated ineligible to handle respective role for a period of one year.

- IV. A cricketer who is facing any ban / suspension by MPCA / BCCI / any Divisional Association / Institution team shall not be eligible to play in the tournament. Any player who conceals such provision will be debarred from participating in any MPCA tournament for a period of two cricket seasons of MPCA.

The punitive decision on above referred situations (7 I, II, III, IV) matter shall be taken by all office bearers together after giving a hearing to the concerned player if need be.

The above referred punitive actions are minimum in nature. In case if the office bearers opine by majority that stricter action is necessitated, the matter can be referred to any appropriate sub-committee / panel of MPCA for its recommendation to the Committee (i.e. Managing Committee).

MPCA AND ALL DIVISIONS should collectively try that no player is being required to face prohibition on multiple occasions for such fault. Hence, the Divisions should also align their penalty provisions on similar line of MPCA (i.e. 2 years excluding the year in which such incidence is detected)

Also, Divisions should furnish details of any player being facing such bar at domestic level within 7 days of such action. To begin with, the details to be shared with MPCA before the start of summer tournament.

8. DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ASCERTAIN THE ELIGIBILITY

- i. List of admissible documents is stated at the end of the rules. **(ANNEXURE I)**
- ii. The player is required to submit a 'self attested' copy of the documents with date.
- iii. Non availability of the document/s cannot be an excuse for allowing a player to skip the requirement.

9. DIGITAL RECORD



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Wherever practicable, MPCA as well as the concerned Division should take elaborate efforts to maintain the digital format of records of permanent nature like date of birth, place of birth, permanent residential address etc.

However, the following categories of players should submit document afresh for each season

- i. Players eligible under bonafide employment / education qualification :
- ii. Players eligible under change in residence due to studies /employment :
- iii. Players eligible under guest player :

10. **TIMELINE**

After conformation with the 'Player Eligibility Rules', the Division is required to adopt the procedure of 'Players Registration' and hence adhering to precise timeline is necessary.

The Players Registration procedure shall commence from 1st September and continue as per the stipulated duration.

11. **MODIFICATION / REVISION TO ABOVE RULES / PROCEDURES**

These rules / procedures shall be assessed by the Tournament Committee every year by June and any modification / revision etc. to be given effect as under –

Significant changes : To be placed before the Managing Committee by 31st July so as to be given effect, or otherwise, from the coming season.

Nominal changes : The Tournament Committee, after passing by majority, shall circulate such modification / revision etc to all Office Bearers and All Participating teams inviting response (with reasonable justification) within a period of 7-10 days. If such modification / revision is upheld by majority, the same shall be made applicable. This procedure should be completed by 31st July.

Non receipt of comments from office bearers / Division shall be deemed to have consent for the modification / revision.

If above is not complied with, the modified / revised rules shall not be made applicable for the forthcoming season.



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NEW

In general, If any rule / condition is newly imposed by BCCI, such rule / condition shall be automatically given effect by MPCA to the extent reasonable and practicable, and after giving due notice to all Divisions.

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PLAYERS REGISTRATION RULES & PROCEDURES

1. These rules shall be called as “**Players Registration Rules**” and shall be effective from **season 2019/20** and shall supersede any other rules in force till then.
2. These rules are meant for registration of a cricketer, eligible as per the 'players eligibility rules', to play in the **MPCA Inter Divisional Tournament / any other tournament** as specified by the Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association.
3. MPCA domestic season shall commence from **1st September** and continue till the last match of the season irrespective of the category of tournament.
4. The registration of a player under these rules shall be the primary responsibility of the concerned player.

MPCA shall annually provide players registration forms to each Division by stipulated date. Such forms shall contain the eligibility rules as well. The forms shall be in English and Hindi.

5. REGISTRATION RULES & PROCEDURES

- 5.1 Players who are eligible to represent any Division are only entitled for registration with MPCA through the respective Division. Kindly refer 'Players' Eligibility Rules'.
- 5.2 It shall be mandatory for the Divisional Cricket Associations Teams to submit **PLAYERS REGISTRATION FORM** for Inter Divisional tournament as per the following schedule –

NEW

Reporting of players for centralised skeletal maturity test	As per schedule provided by MPCA
Submission of registration forms for all tournaments	Atleast 7 days before the commencement of the respective tournament.

Divisions not submitting documents within above period (i.e 7 days before tournament) shall –

- 5.2.1 Bear a penalty of points for win from points table (i.e. in case of multi-day matches the points applicable for outright win, and in case of ltd. over / T20 matches the points meant for a win). It is clarified that even if a division has not earned any / adequate points, the said penalty shall be applicable on assumption basis, and



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5.2.2 Only previously registered players shall be considered for the tournament, and

5.2.3 The subsidy for 'pre-tournament camp' shall be paid proportionate to 'registered' players only.

Above conditions shall be imposed only if MPCA declares the schedule giving a gap of 45 days (to ensure a reasonable timeframe is offered to Divisions to complete activities like selection tournaments, document compilation etc.). In case of shorter duration, needful relaxation shall be given subject to reasonable period being available for scrutiny of forms.

5.3 **Maximum participation** by a player in age group tournaments shall be as under :

U/14, U/15 : Max. 3 years in any tournament, U/18 : Max 4 years , U/22 : Max. 4 years, U/23 : Max 5 years

ANY PLAYER PARTICIPATING IN ANY JUNIOR TOURNAMENT WITHOUT SKELETAL TEST IN THE PAST SHALL PLAY IN SUCH AGE GROUP FOR ONLY 2 YEARS.

5.4 Any Division can send upto **40 registration forms** (as per the specified format) per tournament.

5.5 It is mandatory for any players desirous of participating in Age Group Tournament (upto U-16 as the case may be) for the first time to undergo 'Skeletal Maturity Test' as per the centralised guidelines in this regard.

5.6 Any Division can send players for Centralised Skeletal Test (at designated Hospital by MPCA) as under -

Age group U/14 : Upto 40 players

Age Group U/15 : Upto 30 players

5.7 A player **seeking fresh registration** must submit the self attested photocopy of the following documents along with the original as a proof of residence and proof of date of birth.

PROOF OF RESIDENCE | ANY TWO OF THE FOLLOWING

1. Passport
2. Valid Driving License
3. Landline Telephone Bill/CELLPHONE BILL / Electricity Bill in the name of the player / parents
4. Aadhar Card (in full)
5. Valid Ration Card or similar card issued by the Government.
6. Registered Leave and License Agreement Copy on stamp paper
7. An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the residence of the player/parents.



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PROOF OF DATE OF BIRTH

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1. Birth Certificate issued by Government within **FOUR YEARS** of the date of birth...**SUCH BIRTH CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE IN DIGITAL FORMAT AND SHOULD HAVE BEEN ISSUED BY THE DESIGNATED AUTHORITY HAVING POWER OF REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS.**

OR

2. Birth Certificate issued by Government after lapse of FOUR YEARS of the date of birth, **ALONG WITH ATLEAST ONE** of the following additional documents to be provided
 1. Passport
 2. Certificate, of recent date, from the hospital where birth had taken
 3. Affidavit stating the date of birth

The Birth Certificate should contain the name of child, name of father and mother, date of birth, place of birth, sex, registration number and date of registration.

If the Birth Certificate doesn't contain the name of child, an affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the name of the child.

OUT OF THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS, ATLEAST ONE SHOULD HAVE A PHOTO OF THE PLAYER

NEW

All players, including players registered with MPCA or BCCI in past, shall be required to provide academic marksheet / documents for recent 3 years if demanded by MPCA.

Any player who has discontinued his studies is required to provide a duly notarised affidavit to this effect alongwith original copy of TC issued by last school. Such TC shall be retained by MPCA.

- 5.8 Players needs to self-attest the documents required for New Player Registration and also submit the ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS for verification at the time of Registration. Non compliance of the above requirements shall be liable for deferring the registration till such self-attested / original document is provided.
- 5.9 For all valid Registration Forms received by MPCA within the stipulated date and those who fulfill the pre-requisites of registration, MPCA shall issue a **list of eligible players at the earliest** before the



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start of the match / tournament. **PLAYER REGISTRATION CARD** of such eligible players will be issued if practicable.

- 5.10 **Player has to carry his registration card (if issued by MPCA) with him whenever he is in team for any match.**

The team management should produce the team list and the Original Registration Cards (of all players as per the team list) to the Match Observer / Umpires / Any other Senior Official as directed by MPCA.

If the player and or Division fail to produce the same, such a player shall be treated as unregistered player and he will not be allowed to play in the match / tournament.

In case of any accidental / inadvertent reason for the player to not carry his card, reference can be made to MPCA office on the day before the match.

However, in exceptional circumstances, the Hon. Secretary – MPCA shall have the discretion to allow such player to play in that match / tournament.

5.11 TRANSFER OF PLAYERS :

5.11.1 **Transfer of player from One Division to another shall be applicable for all categories of tournament in that season.**

5.11.2 Any player seeking transfer from one Division to another Division shall have to inform the parent association in writing and obtain a written NOC to play for another Division. Subsequently, any Division interested to rope in such player will have to submit an application to MPCA alongwith the NOC of the earlier Division of the player and the application from the player expressing his desire to play alongwith the REGISTRATION FORM before the stipulated date of submission of form.

Any verbal request for NOC from a junior player (upto age of 16), should be supplemented by giving a 'format request letter'.

The Division issuing NOC as well as the Division desirous to induct such player shall forward a scan copy of the NOC to MPCA within 4-5 days of issuing / receiving.

5.11.3 Transfer applications should be forwarded to MPCA along with the players registration forms.

5.11.4 In exceptional cases, any request for transfer of Division can be considered by the Hon. Secretary, MPCA without NOC of the previous division and the decision taken by the Hon. Secretary shall be final and binding.

5.12 CHANGE OF DETAILS IN RESPECT OF REGISTERED PLAYER



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Change of address will be effected only on production of the original documentary evidence

CHANGE OF DATE OF BIRTH CAN BE DONE ONLY BY THE ORDER OF THE HON'BLE COURT (DECLARATION SUIT). WHILE MPCA HAS NO RESERVATION IN ACCEPTING SUCH REVISION BASED ON A COURT ORDER, BCCI MAY HAVE DIVERGENT POLICY. HENCE, FOR BCCI REGISTRATION THE POLICY ADOPTED BY BCCI SHALL BE VALID.

In case of change of residence due to employment / studies during the year / season, the player shall not be allowed to play for the new team for that season, if he has already played for his old team in any tournament.

5.13 SQUAD ANNOUNCEMENT BY DIVISION

The Division shall announce their squads as under

Tournament	Provisional Squad	Additional Window for Transfer	Registration Form Submission
Tournaments requiring age verification assessment	30 days before the tournament but with availability of players for AVP	Between 30 – 25 days before the tournament	20 days before the tournament
Age group tournaments (not requiring the age verification assessment)	30 days before the tournament but with availability of players for AVP	Between 30 – 25 days before the tournament	20 days before the tournament
Open tournaments	15 days before commencement of tournament.	5 days after announcement of provision squad	10 days before the commencement of the tournament.

Any holiday / non working day shall be adjusted accordingly

5.14 PUNISHMENT & APPEALS

Any player found to be participating in any registered tournament without valid registration shall be debarred from playing in the said tournament for that season and for next two seasons.

Such punishment shall not be extended unless any player is given opportunity of being heard.

Players refused registration and / or transfer under the rules can approach the Hon. Secretary / Incharge of the respective team to consider the objections.

The Hon. Secretary / Incharge may explain the reasons for such refusal if within rules.

If the Hon. Secretary / Incharge desires to seek explanation from MPCA, same shall be forward in writing. Such cases shall be decided on merit under these rules and convey the decision giving reasons.

Such decision of the adjudicating authority with reasons shall be final and binding.

6. MODIFICATION / REVISION TO ABOVE RULES / PROCEDURES



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Nominal changes : The Tournament Committee, after passing by majority, shall circulate such modification / revision etc to all Office Bearers and All Participating teams inviting response (with reasonable justification) within a period of 7-10 days. If such modification / revision is upheld by majority, the same shall be made applicable. This procedure should be completed by 31st July.

Non receipt of comments from office bearers / Division shall be deemed to have consent for the modification / revision.

If above is not complied with, the modified / revised rules shall not be made applicable for the forthcoming season.

NEW

In general, If any rule / condition is newly imposed by BCCI, such rule / condition shall be automatically given effect by MPCA to the extent reasonable and practicable, and after giving due notice to all Divisions.

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ANNEXURE I : DOCUMENTS ACCEPTED AS PROOF OF RESIDENCE / DATE OF BIRTH

BIRTH QUALIFICATION

Birth Certificate issued by Government within **FOUR YEARS** of the date of birth

Birth Certificate issued by Government after lapse of **FOUR YEARS** of the date of birth,

ALONG WITH ATLEAST ONE of the following additional documents to be provided

- Passport
- Certificate from the hospital of recent period
- Affidavit stating the Place of Birth

The Birth Certificate should contain the name of child, name of father and mother, date of birth, place of birth, sex, registration number and date of registration.

If the Birth Certificate doesn't contain the name of child, an affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the name of the child.

AS PER BCCI RULES, BIRTH CERTIFICATE SHALL BE VALID ONLY IF IN DIGITAL FORMAT

FOR ANY PLAYER BORN OUTSIDE THE JURISDICTION OF INDIA, VALID PASSPORT IS MANDATORY.

BONAFIDE RESIDENCE QUALIFICATION

ANY TWO OF THE FOLLOWING

- Passport
- Valid Driving License
- Landline Telephone Bill/CELLPHONE BILL / Electricity Bill in the name of the player / parents
- Aadhar Card (in full)
- Valid Ration Card or similar card issued by the Government.
- Registered Leave and License Agreement Copy on stamp paper
- An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the residence of the player/parents.

BONAFIDE EMPLOYMENT / EDUCATION QUALIFICATION PLAYER

ANY TWO OF THE FOLLOWING (AS PER THE CATEGORY)

IN CASE OF EMPLOYMENT

- Certificate from the employer stating the details of the player/parents with period since employed.
- Employment identity card
- Salary slip for atleast three consecutive months
- An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the employment.

IN CASE OF EDUCATION

- Certificate from the education institution stating the details of the player/parents with period since studying.
- Identity card issued by the educational institution
- Marks sheet or equivalent document
- An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the education.

- An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the employment.

IN CASE OF EDUCATION

- Certificate from the education institution stating the details of the player/parents with period since studying.
- Identity card issued by the educational institution
- Marks sheet or equivalent document
- An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the education.

PLAYERS REPRESENTING INSTITUTION/PLAYER (PERSONAL / PARENTS)

ANY TWO OF THE FOLLOWING (AS PER THE CATEGORY)

- Certificate from the employer stating the details of the player/parents with period since employed.
- Employment identity card
- Salary slip for atleast three consecutive months
- An affidavit signed by living parents (one/both), along with a copy of identity of such parents, is required to be submitted specifying the employment.
