- (ii) Retired umpires' on the 'State Panel' of MPCA and 'BCCI Panel'**

1. MPCA's 'Monthly Benevolence Contribution Scheme' ('MBC') is applicable to the concerned persons who fulfill the following eligibility parameters

<b>MALE PLAYERS CATEGORY</b>	<b>UMPIRES CATEGORY</b>
The scheme shall be applicable to those former first class players who are not covered under similar scheme offered by the BCCI or any other state association.	The scheme shall be applicable to those former BCCI panel / MPCA state panel umpires who are not covered under the monthly gratis scheme offered by the BCCI or any other state association.
Any beneficiary can be entitled for the monthly gratis only under one category. (ie. Either as a player or as an umpire, whichever is higher)	Any beneficiary can be entitled for the monthly gratis only under one category. (ie. Either as a player or as an umpire, whichever is higher)
The scheme is applicable for the cricketers who have represented Holkar / MP team in BCCI first class cricket. Players who have represented any other team (alongwith Holkar / MP) shall not be eligible	The scheme will be applicable for the umpires who have crossed 55 years of age.
The scheme is applicable to those cricketers who have featured in playing xi only.	The scheme is applicable only after announcement of retirement from umpiring.
The scheme is applicable only after announcement of retirement from first class cricket and upon crossing 40 years of age.	The scheme is not applicable posthumous (i.e. after the life of the umpire)
The scheme is not applicable posthumous (i.e. after the life of the cricketer)	

2. MPCA has been periodically appealing to the prospective candidates (who are potentially eligible for the benefits of the MBC) to enroll under the scheme.
3. This is a final call for such former players / umpires who are eligible for the benefits of the MBC to enroll under the scheme on or before 31.12.2021.
4. Anyone applying for enrollment on or after 1.1.2022 shall not receive benefits for the period prior to enrollment.
