Sub Committee : Cricket Development Committee

Report period : Oct ~ Dec. 2019

The Cricket Development Committee discussed in detail, by taking into account different issues and/or ideas of the members, on the following significant work areas :

Sr. No	Nature of work	Financial outlay estimated, if any
1	Format of inter-divisional tournaments : Advice the Divisional Tournament & Technical Committee to conduct U/13, U/15 tournaments (boy's) with two groups and matches of 2-day duration aiming to provide more matches in comparison to what a team can get in existing format. Similarly, conduct the U/19, U/23 and Senior Tournaments (Men's) on knock-out basis to enhance competitiveness.	NIL
2	Players eligibility norms : With ground support from the Divisions, efforts shall be taken to further strengthen the norms for ensuring bonafide MP born / based players get opportunities to participate in Divisional Tournaments.	NIL
3	Monitoring system : In view of the diverse cricket-oriented schemes of MPCA in place already, and being well responded by the Divisional cricket association, there is no major new scheme to be launched. The situation now solicits appropriate monitoring of the schemes in place so that the outcome is optimum. Hence, the CDC decides to nominate members as coordinating liaison for each division.	Approx. 5 Lac per year towards TA/DA to members for visits to hold meeting, monitor the activities etc.

Sub Committee : Finance Committee

Report period : Oct ~ Dec. 2019

The Finance Committee discussed in detail, by taking into account different issues and/or ideas of the members, on the following significant work areas :

Sr. No	Nature of work	Financial outlay estimated, if any
1	Physical verification of assets : The effect of the variances, if any, to be taken in the current financial year (2019-20) at the time of finalisation / audit.	NIL
2	Deduction of provident fund for all the employees (i.e. whether permanent or temporary) as per the statutory norms.	TBC
3	Course of action in response to the audit conducted by the Service Tax department for period from 2014 to June 2017.	TBC
4	TOD : As on 23.12.2019, the Overdraft taken during previous one odd year owing to stoppage of funds from BCCI was paid 100% in November. However, we may still require such OD in future since the regular influx of funds from BCCI has not restored fully.	
5	The committee adopted the excess of interest on TOD than the budgeted amount, considering the fact that the TOD was required for a considerably longer period than estimated when the budget was prepared sometime in June 2019. The funds from BCCI were not received till the first interim payment in November. Hence, we had to continue with OD for almost 5 excess months. This also necessitates a recommendation to the Committee (Managing Committee) that the interest on OD will have to be accounted for on actual basis henceforth since there is no surety of further fund from BCCI. 6	Committee took note about the completion of the assessment of the ITR for AY 17-18. The refund of Rs 1,09,04,087 was received on 29.10.2019 and the balance amount of Rs 98,37,083 was adjusted against some outstanding demand.	NIL
7	Approval of the budget for the India - Sri Lanka T20 International to be conducted by MPCA at Holkar Stadium on 07.01.2020.	As per budget
